Week 19

Visual Perception

Ask your child to name as many things as she can that are the same colour as something that you name:

An apple has the same colour as ...

Milk is the same colour as ...

Mathematical Skills

Start teaching your child to identify different coins in your currency.

Gross Motor Skills

Let your child run up a flight of stairs. This develops foot-eye co-ordination. Let her jump down with both feet together.

Fine Motor Skills

Let your child do rubbings of firm leaves or coins. Show her how to hold the paper firmly and use the flat side of a crayon or pencil point to rub over the shape. Go to [leaf rubbing craft](#) for a printable poem about leaves.

Auditory Perception

Play the musical memory game at Jambav.com. Your child has to use the mouse to play the notes of a keyboard in a special sequence. The sequence gets longer and longer developing her auditory memory.

Faith Building

Last week you discussed the 'weeds' of sin in our lives. Explain to your children that in order for us to be children of God, our sins need to be confessed and forgiven. Once they have done this, they need to also share with others the message of 1 John 1 :9 "*If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins...*"

Let your child learn this verse by heart.
